# THE FOUR QUESTION METHOD

## Understanding & Applying God's Word

Following these four steps in Bible Study can help us to remain focused in our study and intentional in our application. Feel free to use this as a personal study supplement, with children, with small groups, or with other bible studies.

### 1. WHAT IS THE CONTEXT?



What kind of literature are you reading? Who is the author? Who is the audience? When was it written? Why was it written? The context will always lead the meaning of the passage.

### 2. WHAT DOES THIS PASSAGE SAY?



Try to understand exactly what the words of scripture say. Think about what God was wanting to say through the author. What is the meaning of the text in light of the context?

### 3. WHAT DOES THIS PASSAGE TEACH YOU ABOUT GOD?



Since God is the author and the main character in Scripture, He is continually revealing Himself to His readers. Meditate on God's character, personality, and actions.

### 4. WHAT DOES THIS PASSAGE LEAD YOU TO BELIEVE/DO?



How does this speak to your situation, your struggles, your actions, and your thoughts. How are you supposed to live, think, and follow God because of what you have learned in this passage?
